"We are making our bid only as a last resort." Frank Ollendorff. city manager of Northville, explained.

"We can't handle the entire parcel. but we could make good use of 200 acres for such things as a golf course, swimming pools, trails for horse back riding and other features to attract nature lovers and outdoor people."

with THIS gathering in-terest in preserving the area for a park, the two state leg-islators - Sen. Carl Pursell 1R-Plymouth) and Rep. Marvin Stempien (D-Li-vonia) - urged the Dept. of Natural Resources to become involved to the extent of making a bid. As a result, the DNR adopted a resolution to that effect. Now the matter is up to the State Legislature to approve the use of the funds from the state recreation bond issue. In urging the department

In urging the department to make the bid, Pursell pointed out that last year, as a member of the Wayne County Board of Commissioners, he attempted to interest the Huron-Clinton Metropolitan Authority in acquiring the area for park purposes.
