"I want to hear your dreams and your vision of what this college should be," Fulton told a standing-room-only audience Friday at the school's Orchard Ridge Campus. She doesn't assume her full du-



ties until Friday. But she said she enjoyed talking to her new col-leagues — their first since Fulton was named chancellor in Decem-ber — dearly because of the chal-lenges ahead.

"I'm a risk-taker," Fulton said.
"I'm willing to take calculated risks" to further the main objectives... serving students and the community.

FULTON, who resigned as president of Brookhaven College in the Dallas area to become OCC chancellor, said the weeks ahead will be dedicated to talking with staff, Jaculty and community leaders.

"I will learn by listening," she said. "I will respond honestly and lead with high expectations." Put-ton said he accepted the OCC Job because of the school's high reputation to quality education and serving students.

But an uncertain future — including the current recession — will present new challenges. "We'll have to fulfill our mission with hewer resources," she said, keep the quality high with fewer dollars.
