Jordache commercial a good fit for Joe Lara's acting career

Q: Could you please tell me who played Wolf, the half-breed Apache, in Gunslinger: The Last Apache? How old is he? This is my first time writing someone like you, so please respond. —Shannon Samson, Kingman, Ariz.

A: Twenty-eight-year-old Joe Lara played Wolf in *Gunslinger: The Last Apache*. Born and raised in San Diego, Calif., at age 19 he turned down a volleyball scholarship offer so he could model in Paris. Doing photos was not enough for him, so upon his return to the States he started taking acting classes at Orange Coast community college. In 1988 he was selected for the Jordache jeans TV commercial. This led to his film debut in the 1989 CBS film *Tarzan in Manhattan*. He has a studio apartment in north Hollywood, where he resides with his 5-1/2-foot-long Burmese python.

Q: I am so impressed with the performance of Rodney A. Grant in both Dances With Wolves and the ABC movie Son of Morning Star, that I would like to know more about him. Also, where could I write him? —Ruth Ross, Kingman, Ariz.

A: Rodney Grant, an American Indian, was born in Winnebago, Neb. Raised by his grandmother, he grew up on the Omaha Tribal Reservation. She encouraged him to make something of

his life, so at age 17 he joined the U.S. Marines. Later, motivated by an apparent scarcity of American Indian actors, Grant auditioned for and won a small part in the Nebraska Educational Television documentary *We Are One*. This was followed by a role in another PBS production, *The Trail of Standing Bear*. His theatrical films include *Pow Wow Highway*, *Broken Documents*, and *War Party*. He can be seen in Oliver Stone's film *The Doors*. An address is not available at this time.

Q: I would appreciate it very much if you could give me Chad McQueen's address and James Whitmore's, as I would really love to write them both. —Alan Carney, Powell, Tenn.

A: Your letter was very interesting, and I especially enjoyed receiving the pictures. However, the addresses you requested have not been released. Many write in for addresses of the stars. Unfortunately, the addresses I have on hand are not always correct. Celebrities frequently change their addresses and/or their agents. It would be a full-time job to keep up with them. I suggest you write to the Screen Actors Guild, 7065 Hollywood Blvd., Hollywood, CA 90028. They may be able to supply you with the addresses you need.

Q: I have a question concerning National Lampoon's Vacation and National Lampoon's European Vacation. Are Rusty and Audrey played by the same young people? —Wilburn Holland, Brownwood, Texas

A: No, the actors are not the same in the two films. Audrey was played by Dana Holland and Rusty by Jason Lively in *National Lampoon's European Vacation*. Dana Barron played Audrey and Anthony Michael Hall played Rusty in *National Lampoon's Vacation*.

Q: I would like to have an address for Vivien Leigh. She is one of my favorite actresses. Gone With the Wind is my favorite film.

A: Vivien Leigh suffered ill health throughout most of her career. She died in May 1967 at the age of 53, when she experienced a recurrence of tuberculosis.
