Clinton Council Seeking \$55,000

The 1971 annual sustaining membership enrollment of the Clinton Valley Council, Boy Scouts of America, is under way in the Oakland and Macomb county area served by the council, which includes Farmington and Southfield.

Chairman of the enrollment, Robert W. Podlesak, general manufacturing manager of the GMC Truck & Coach Division of General Motors, said the council is seeking a minimum of \$55,000 in the 1971 effort to meet this year's operating budget.

Podlesak said, "They provide the funds necessary to serve the council's current scouting program; they provide growth funds vital for the expansion of the program during 1971, and they provide a means for individuals to financially aid scouting."

The council last year experienced a nine per cent growth in membership - greater than any of the 73 Scout councils in the Midwest. Currently the council serves more than 13,500 cub scouts, boy scouts and explorers in 327 units in all of Macomb County north of the 14 Mile Road and all of Oakland County with the exception of the four southeastern townships. Nearly 4,000 adult volunteer leaders assist in the council program.
