Printing Firm Selects Livonia

The 37-year-old Robins Printing Co., long based in Detroit, will move its entire operation into Livonia next month.

This announcement was made by William C. Robins, general manager and a Farmington resident. The firm will move from its location at 11343 Schaefer Highway to a 2 1/2-acre site at 13305 Wayne Rd. in the Schoolcraft Industrial Park. The company's new 22,000-square-foot building includes more than 4,000 square feet of offices, sales and customer conference areas, and is located one block south of Schoolcraft (the future I-96 Jeffries Freeway).

THE NEW operation offers a widely diversified plant with IBM cold type composition, camera and layout departments, a duplicating division with "while-you-wait" printing facilities, a sheet-fed press room, and a bindery with all modern high-speed equipment. Recent equipment purchases, according to Robins, include a two-color 38-inch offset press, a high-speed 36 inch single-color press, a

31-inch camera with temperature-controlled sink, a cutter, and collating and miscellaneous bindery items.

Robins pointed out this marks the firm's third move in 10 years, a situation he attributes to continuous expanding sales. "So far we have been serving the industry in metropolitan Detroit only," he noted. "However, we can now expand our activities to include all of southeastern Michigan."

The firm employs 45 persons and is moving into its new quarters on a lease-purchase agreement. The company was started in 1934 by James E. Robins Sr. as a one-man duplicating service in the basement of his home. Now the firm is managed by his three sons. Besides William, the others are Robert E., controller, and James E. Jr., sales manager, who are both Livonia residents. Other key personnel are Ken Willey, plant manager; Judy Manthei, head estimator; and Dave Duncan, Murray Jourdan and Ken Roberts, all salesmen.

First Offenders Program Approved By Board

A pilot program for community treatment of first and second offenders has been approved by the Oakland County Board of Commissioners. Commissioners voted to appropriate \$41,126 to the Michigan Council on Crime and Delinquency for the program.

The cost will be \$3,000 per person, less than the average cost per inmate at the Jackson State Prison. Oakland County will contribute 25% of the total cost with the rest to be paid by a federal grant and the National Council on Crime and Delinquency.

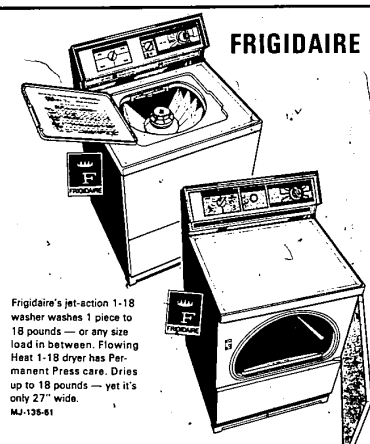
