It will open not with Mendelssohn's "Spring Song," but with his Hebrides Overture. The orchestra will also play Bartok's Concerto for Orchestra, featuring solos by various instruments.

SHE RECEIVED her musical education through scholarship awards. A graduate of the Toronto Conservatory and the Juillard School of Music, she has appeared with the Toronto, Detroit and Dearborn Symphony Orchestras. She has also made many radio and television appearances in the U.S. and Canada.
