Arrangements were made by the Thayer-Rock Funeral Home, Farmington.

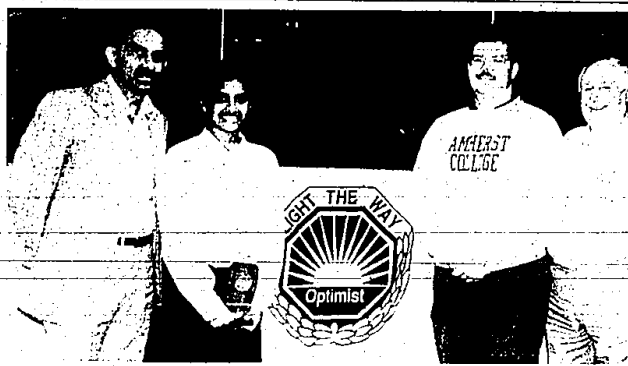
KENNETH W. SCHOFER

two daughters and a son, who all attend Power Middle School in Farmington Hills.

"I can't work for somebody," he added, sharing his entrepreneurial philosophy. "Maybe sometimes I work for free, or I work for the landlord. Still, I'm happy."

Doing business for 18 years at the Roman Terrace location and in Detroit for several years prior to that, Aon has developed a client list which includes a number of local celebrities, politicians and business leaders. He said losing touch with people for a year was more than devastating to business — he simply missed them.

"They tell you about insurance — but it doesn't cover the pleasure of working," he said. "You get up in the

morning and suddenly you don't have work, or help."

AON IS STARTING from scratch, since his employees went elsewhere to make a living after the fire. He is still seeking several stylists, and answers many of his own phone calls between hair cuts.

He said Farmington has been his home for 25 years, and will remain so. "This is my area here," he said. "I'll stick with it and I'll make it. This is a successful area. I am optimistic about the future."

On Aon's wall hangs a tribute from Farmington's Odemaker, Trudi Blake, which states, in part: "Long live the Glorious Groomer and his admiring clients, for Abe has made of barbering an art, a craft, a science."

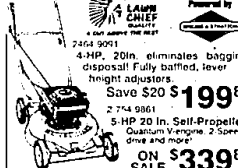

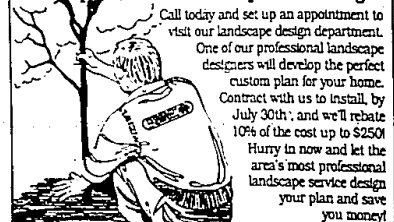
