# Oakland Moves To Part-Time Road Board

The first step toward making the Oakland County Road Commission a part-time, policy-making board was taken Thursday by the Oakland County Board of Commissioners.

A new appointee to the three-man commission will be paid \$75 per day up to \$7,500 annually on a part-time basis to fill a vacant position on the board. Road Commissioner Sol Lomerson, who retired Jan. 1, was paid an annual salary of \$13,500.

THE CUT, approved by an 18-5 vote, came after four years of controversy and one hour of heated debate Thursday. It was generally agreed that the action was a matter of policy and principle, rather than money.

# Working Woman Has To Be Super

For a woman to succeed, or even get started in a male-dominated profession, she has to be exceptionally talented and iron-willed, according to a number of working women.

"In the field, women have to fight constantly to excel to more than a man," one said.

This opinion was echoed by several working women who participated in a series of workshops at Oakland Community College's Orchard Ridge branch. The workshops were part of a full day of activities to commemorate International Women's Day.

WOMEN'S DAY originated in 1857 when women began a struggle to protest poor working conditions, low wages and a 56-hour work week in textile factories.

Today many women voice similar complaints regarding job discrimination, and several women came armed with these complaints to OCC's teach-in.

"Women have to do twice as much to achieve," one said.

One woman told of a few professional lawyers who complained that they would have to offer positions to two women lawyers because the women were the top graduates in their class. It is just a small example of what frequently occurs, she said.

"One thing that bothers me the most is the role the secretary plays to the men," another added. "Many (bosses) believe the woman is their property."
