**Slide Program Planned**

On Tuesday, Oct. 15 at 8 p.m., Dr. James Wilson, of Windsor, will present a program in the WJW Auditorium, sponsored by the Detroit Audubon Society, and open to the public without charge.

The first part of the program will show slides of Lake Okechobee, Fla. Here Dr. Wilson will show the rare Everglade Kite, a bird seen by very few people.

The next part of his trip will take us to Churchill, Manitoba, Churchill is in the treeless area on Hudson Bay. This very northern town is reached only by railroad, so often is not even shown on road maps. His slides will bring us close-ups of the many nesting shorebirds of this area. He will also show the beautiful tundra flowers.

## Parks Attendance Up

The four major parks of the Huron-Clio Metropolitan Authority showed increased usage at most of its sites during the month of September compared to the same month in 1967.

Kensington Metropolitan Park near Milford reported over 177,000 persons used the park in September to set a record for the month. Last year's usage was 152,000 for September of 1967 and the previous high was 166,000 set during the month of September of 1965.

Lower Huron Metropolitan Park near Belleville reported over 156,300 visitors during September compared to 150,900 for the same month last year. The highest figure for the month was 166,000 set in 1964.

Stony Creek Metropolitan Park near Utica had over 89,700 visitors in September, compared to 81,900 persons in September of last year. However, the record figure for September is 98,500 set during the park's first year of operation, 1964.

Metropolitan Beach near Mt. Clemens is the only Huron-Clio park that showed a decline in attendance for the month of September. This year's usage was 94,900 persons compared to a record 111,100 set last September.
