

U-M Enrollment Rises But Below Anticipations

University of Michigan enrollment stands at 36,021 this fall, 738 more than a year ago. When credit extension students are omitted, the total enrollment is 35,242, up 728.

This is less than half of one per cent lower than the 35,410 which University officials anticipated when they requested the current state appropriation nearly a year ago.

According to Allan F. Smith, vice president for academic affairs, it is considerably higher than was expected last winter, when draft exemptions were eliminated for all graduate students except those in the health sciences.

and partly because of efforts by the University's Law School and its Housing H. Rackham School of Graduate Studies.

The Law School made a deliberate effort to enlarge its freshman class, admitting 424 in contrast to last year's 359. Even so, many qualified applicants had to be turned away because of space and faculty limitations.

Total Law School enrollment this year is 1,087, up from 1,059 last year.

Rackham enrollment stands at 8,337 this year, down from last year by only 277, about 3 per cent. It was here that the greatest impact of the draft-law changes had been expected.

That impact was largely alleviated by delaying the application cut-off date by several weeks and by admitting more of the fully qualified students who in other years might have been turned away for space reasons.

THE DRAFT-LAW changes cut enrollment most sharply in the School of Business Administration, from 1,271 last

year to 1,072 this year. Nearly all of the drop was in the business administration degrees; this fell from 904 to 712.

Significant enrollment increases were recorded in several of U-M's 17 colleges and schools.

At Flint College enrollment group seeking master of business jumped from 1,030 to 1,373, chiefly because of the expanded freshman class, Smith said. The college admitted 176 freshmen last year. But this year after stepping up recruiting visits to Flint area high schools, the college admitted 228.

Here are the current enrollment figures, and last fall's figures:

College of Architecture and Design, 820, up from 811; Dearborn Campus, 809 up from 776; School of Dentistry, 563, up from 534; School of Education, 3,345, up from 3,312; College of Engineering, 4,490, down

from 4,531; School of Music, 875, up from 870; School of Natural Resources, 442, up from 412; School of Nursing, 823, up from 816; College of Pharmacy, 257, up from 234. Those figures include gra-

duate as well as undergraduate students. In addition, there are 240 graduate students in inter-college programs, up from 219. There are 2,775 students in credit extension work now, 10 more than last year.

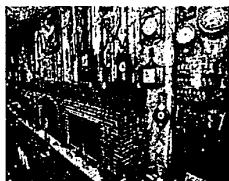

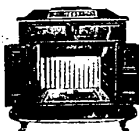
