Carol Wald show opens up north

Michigan painter Carol Wald will have two exhibitions at the new Michael and Barbara Dennis Museum Center at Northwestern Michigan College of Traverse City, opening with a 6-9 p.m. reception Friday.

The exhibitions, "Paintings from Michigan Collections" and "Sequences & Transformations," recent paintings, continue through Nov. 3.

Wald, born in Detroit, studied at Detroit Society of Arts and Crafts and later at Cranbrook Academy of Art.

She works in oil, watercolor, pastel, crayon, acrylic and collage, often in large format. Her imagery is filled with a dreamlike quality, so the viewer often feels that he is entering the narrative, just before or after something important has taken place. For just a second Wald has stopped the action which appears destined to pick up again at any moment.

Wald has won national awards for her work as an artist as well as that as an illustrator. In 1990 she won the visual artist award from the Arts Foundation of Michigan along with three other major awards.
