New laws list responsibilities, including licensing and cleanup

A cat control ordinance was approved in the city of Farmington Monday, making cat owners responsible for licensing, immunization and cleanup of their pets.

The measure, introduced earlier this month and approved unanimously by the city council, will go into cifect in 60 days. That will give city staff time to decide how to handle fifth licensing situation, said public safety director Frank Lauhoff.

Based on experiences in other cities, he expects only about 50 licenses to be Issued.

The city council in neighboring Farmington Hills also approved a cat control measure Monday.
