Meanwhile, Nagel said Young's order was the fifth received at the West Bloomfield store since the Shoppers Express program began there last week. Kroger actually announced Sept. 9 as the official start-up date.

Both Nagel and Layne said the service should be a hit with senior citizens, who make up about 25 percent of the store's customers.

"The response so far has been very good. They (seniors) seem very interested," Nagel said. More customers of all ages should

start using Shoppers Express as winter comes, Layne said. "As it gets colder and darker earlier, that's when we expect the big surge."

IT'S NOT exactly the way it was in 1883, when the chain's founder, Barney Kroger instituted household delivery.

The program relies on state-of-the-art technology, although the personalized touch still is a vital ingredient.

"The majority of our customers are those with double incomes and families," said Kara Kernan, marketing vice president for Shopper's Express. "For somebody who works it's easier to pick up the phone than spend two hours at the supermarket."

Since the Sept. 9 start-up, "we've served hundreds and hundreds of orders every day, just a tremendous response," Kernan added.

For the purpose of RECEIVING APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION of the qualified electors in said CITY, Electors who wish to vote in the General City and Oakland County Special Election must be registered to vote no later than 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 7, 1991. Persons may register at any Secretary of State branch office, county clerk's office or city clerk's office.

The purpose of the GENERAL CITY ELECTION is to elect four council members for regular terms and to vote on the following CITY BOND PROPOSITION: Shall the City of Farmington Hills borrow an amount not to exceed One Million Six Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,625,000) and issue its general obligation bonds for the purpose of defraying the City's share of the cost of expanding and renovating the existing 47th District Court building and site to accommodate the addition of a third District Court judge?

The purpose of the OAKLAND COUNTY SPECIAL ELECTION is for voting on the following BOND PROPOSITION: Shall the County of Oakland, Michigan, borrow a sum of money not to exceed Five Hundred Million Dollars (\$500,000,000) and issue its full faith and credit general obligation bonds therefor, in one or more series (the principal and interest on such bonds to be paid primarily from the revenues to be derived from the operation of the Oakland County Solid Waste Management System), to defray the cost of acquiring, constructing and equipping solid waste processing and disposal facilities to serve the Oakland County Solid Waste Management System, including, without limitation, a household hazardous waste program, one or more recycling facilities, one or more composting facilities, a waste-to-energy incinerator and a sanitary landfill?
