I want to work in white, middle-class suburbia because it's where the power is," Neff said. "Society needs many changes, and they are not going to occur without imputus from the white middle class."



Parish work was his choice in part because of his counseling training.

"I'd like to help people get from birth to death and feel good about it-with as little pain and as much excitement as possible," he explained. Ane he described his new congregation, which draws

people with a liberal outlook from all parts of this area, as "one of the most exciting groups of people I've ever met." NEFF CALLED himself

NEFF CALLED himself arrity among Unitarians because Im a theologian." "People in my denomination tend to be terrified of the word God," he added, "but I use it frquently. It is a term that means different things to different people, and I let others shift for themselves in dealing with it." But words like "guilt" and "penitence" don't fit into Neff's theology. "Religion has to be fun, and life a celebration," he said.

Among his first major projects in the Farmington U-U church is the launching of two counseling groups, one for married couples and one

for single persons.
"To be single in the sub-urbs is difficult, to say the least," Neff said.

HE HOPES LATER to become involved in commun-ity matters "as issues grab me."

"My outlook in social mat-ters tends to be beyond the liberal-radical, I guess, but unorganized," he stated. "I can't even join an anarchist

"But I feel organized religion up to now has led us only into a great chasm, and salvation must be on a individual level. Just making political changes either way doesn't work."

Mrs. Neff, a University of Chicago graduate, is working on a novel and teaching soci-ology at Schoolcraft Com-munity College.

"She also is interested in women's liberation move-ment, which I am too," said her husband.
