Now that you have given publicity in so far as possible to the extension of street car service to your city and completion of the pavement on Grand River avenue, would it not be timely to agitate and acquire either a two hour bus service from Orchard Lake to the Junction or a resumption of the street car on this division?

Do you know that there are fifty or more families living in and near the Orchard or Orchard Lake road between the 12 and 13-Mile roads? Do you know that without transportation property values are bound to decrease and that the Farmington merchants must be losing business every day? Of course, nearly all the men have autos or arrangements with their neighbors to go to and from their work but what provision is there for the women folks when they have a desire to shop?

City and County officials can at least make an effort to improve this condition and the community newspaper can, if it cares to, assist very materially.
