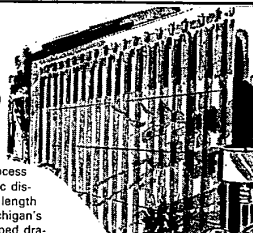

He said the course offers a "new approach to discipline and a more effective way of handling any and all conflicts that are sure to arise in every family."

He added that the course is helpful to parents of adolescents because the method "noticeably lessens the storm and stress so common between teen-agers and parents as they come into conflict over dating, smoking, drinking, driving, dress, manners, studying and almost everything else."

"The children can begin acting responsibly and cooperatively at an early age, and parents of young children have more time to become more skillful in the new method before problems get serious."

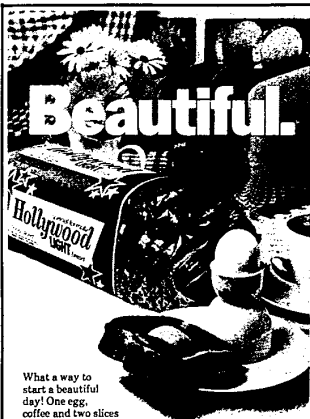
