the proposed athletic field and stadium, increase in the area of the cemetery, the transportation to Detroit problem, new business buildings and homes, and Northwestern Highway and Telegraph road.

Urges Continuous Aid

Mr. Hatton urged that the Exchange Club, have a standing committee watching developments in every one of these projects, and lending aid wherever necessary, at the same time keeping the club informed upon them.
