

NFH Graduates First Baptist Buses Begin Medical Studies At WSU Travel New Route

Three graduates of North Farmington High School are enrolled as first-year students in the Wayne State University School of Medicine. They are Michel A. Sucher, son of Mr. and Mrs. Harold M. The First Baptist Church of Farmington will institute a new Bible school bus route today, Sunday, Oct. 13, under the direction of school superintendent Dick Stevens.

The bus will leave the church at 8:45 a.m., circulate the city by going south on Wilmarth and Fleming, east on Freedom Rd. and Cloverdale, north on Lilac and Springbrook, and west on 10 Mile, Leelanee and Glen Orchard, then south again on Farmington Rd. to the church. Those living on or near these streets are asked to check the map in The Enterprise & Observer for the approximate time of arrival and then flag the bus down as it passes the street. The route may be altered if families phone the church to request pickup on a street not now covered.

Also today, Sunday, the church will hold a food shower and farewell reception for the Earl Harrison family following the evening service. The Harrisons and their 11 children who have lived in Farmington for 20 years, are moving to the Conservative Baptist Church Camp near Houghton Lake, Mich.

On Wednesday, Oct. 16, the Rev. Weldon Clark, missionary to Canada from the Conservative Baptist Home Mission Society, will be guest speaker at the Farmington church. Bible study and prayer time will begin at 7:30 p.m.

The church Bible school is holding a contest through Nov. 3 with the theme, "Hunting for Families."

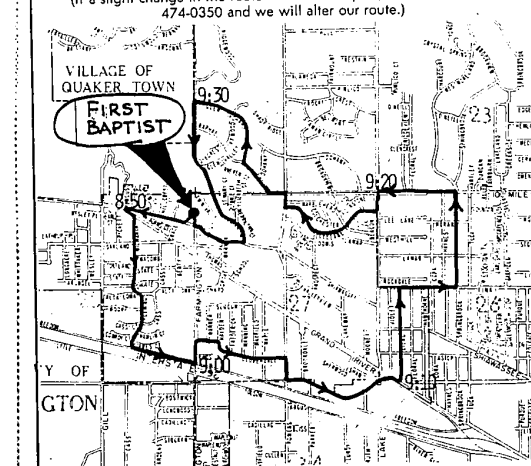
