

Section 3. It shall be the duty of every owner, po58-essor or oc-cupier of land or of every person or persons, firm or corporation having charge of any, lands in this Gity of Farmington to cut or eause to be cut down and destroy-ied all Canada thieles, milkwead (asclepias cornutus), wild car-rots, oxey, daisies or other nox-lous weads growing thereon, at least twice in each year, once bo-fore the first day of July and again before the first day of Sep-tember; and as much oftener as may be necessary to prevent their going to seed, and if any owner possessor of land, or any person or persons, firm or corporation having charge of any lands in this City of Farmington shall knowingly suffer any Canada thistles, milkweed, wild carrots or other noxious weeds to grow thereon, or shall suffer the need to ripen, so as to cause or en-danger the spread thereof, he or they shall, on conviction in any court of competent jurisdiction be liable to a fine of ten dollars, togother with costs of prosecu-tion, for every offense and he or they shall pay the cost of cutting and destroying such weeds and an additional ten per centum as hereinafter provided. Section 4. It shall be the duty of the Superintendent of Public Works in the City of Parmington to give general notice in the fol-lowing manner to every owner, possessor or occupier of land and to every person or persons, firm or corporation having charge of any lands in this City of Farmington, whereon noxious weeds are grow-ing, to cut and destroy such nox-ious weeds.
