A Person-to-Person call costs the same at all hours. 2--Station-to-Station. This is a call placed for a certain telephone number and is the kind of call to make when you are reasonably certain that the person with whom you wish to talk will answer the telephone or can be called to it quickly. Station-to-Station calls cost appreciably less than Person-to-Person calls, and offer re-duced Evening rates, from 7:00 p.m. to 8:30 p.m., and further reduced Night rates, from 8:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. There is no change of rates at midnight. It helps speed the connection if you give the Long Distance operator the number of the distant telephone, when making a Station-to-Station call, but it is not necessary to give it. If you do not know the number, tell the operanot know the number, tell the opera-tor, for instance, that you are calling the office or home of "Mr. John Smith, 350 Sayre Street, Lansing, Michigan;" she will then connect you with the called telephone and give you the number for future use.
