



Walk to start special art nights

In a coordinated effort to accommodate the busy work schedules of art commissioners and visitors, the galleries in downtown Birmingham, north of Maple on Woodward, have formed The North Woodward Gallery.

The new organization will plan simultaneous openings, lectures and a series of special events throughout the year on the first Thursday evening of each month. Hours will be extended on those occasions to 8:30 p.m.

The First Thursday kickoff event will be a festive holiday art walk, complete with white lights, strolling carolers, street vendors and horse and buggy transportation.

AS A special focus this holiday season, the Birmingham galleries will lend their support to their struggling counterparts, the area non-profits, who will be given the opportunity to display their culturally rich pro-




