TO ALL PERSONS AND ENTITIES WITH CLAIMS AGAINST ANY OF THE ABOVE-NAMED DEBTOR ENTITIES:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that each of the above-named debtors (collectively, the "Debtors") commenced a case under chapter 11 of title 11 of the United States Code (the "Bankruptcy Code") in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Northern District of Indiana, South Bend Division (the "Bankruptcy Court") on November 13, 1991 (the "Petition Date").

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Bankruptcy Court has entered an order (the "Bar Date Order") requiring all persons and entities, including individuals, partnerships, corporations, estates, trusts and governmental units, EXCEPT THOSE PERSONS AND ENTITIES DESCRIBED IN PARAGRAPHS A THROUGH E BELOW, to assert a claim (as defined below) against any of the Debtors that arose prior to the Petition Date, to file a proof of such claim by delivering the proof of claim to:

so that it is actually received on or before 5:00 p.m. C.S.T. on Wednesday, January 15, 1992 (the "Bar Date"). Such proofs of claim will be deemed filed only when they are actually received. In accordance with the Bar Date Order, in filing a proof of claim, you must set forth the specific name of the Debtor or Debtors against which you assert a claim or claims. If you have a claim against more than one of the Debtors, you must file a separate claim for each Debtor. As used herein, the term "claim" means (a) right to payment, whether or not such right is reduced to judgment, liquidated, unliquidated, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, legal, equitable, secured or unsecured; or (b) right to an equitable remedy for breach of performance if such breach gives rise to a right to payment, whether or not such right to an equitable remedy is reduced to judgment, fixed, contingent, matured, unmatured, disputed, undisputed, secured or unsecured.

IF YOU ARE REQUIRED TO FILE A PROOF OF CLAIM AND FAIL TO DO SO IN THE MANNER PRESCRIBED, YOU WILL BE FOREVER BARRED FROM VOTING UPON, OR RECEIVING DISTRIBUTIONS UNDER, ANY PLAN OR PLANS OR REORGANIZATION FOR ANY OF THE DEBTORS, AND WILL BE FOREVER BARRED FROM ASSERTING ANY SUCH CLAIM AGAINST ANY OF THE DEBTORS OR THEIR SUCCESSORS OR ASSIGNS.

The following persons or entities are NOT required to file a proof of claim on or before the Bar Date:

- Any person or entity that has already filed a proof of claim conforming substantially to the claim form of the Official Forms against the Debtors with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court.
- Any person or entity (i) whose claim is not listed as "disputed," "contingent" or "unliquidated" in the Debtors' Schedules of Liabilities (the "Schedules"), to be filed with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court on or before December 18, 1991, and (ii) who agrees with the classification and amount set forth therein.
- Any Debtor, on account and any intercompany claim against another Debtor.
- Any person or entity having a claim allowable under section 507(a)(1) of the Bankruptcy Code as an administrative expense of the Debtors' chapter 11 cases.
- Any person or entity having a claim allowed by order of the Court entered on or prior to the Bar Date.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that acts or omissions of any Debtor that occurred prior to the Petition Date may give rise to claims against such Debtor notwithstanding the fact that such claims for the injuries on which they are based) may be contingent or may not have occurred, matured or become fixed or liquidated prior to such date. Therefore, any creditor having a claim or potential claim against a Debtor, no matter how remote or contingent, must file a proof of claim on or before the Bar Date.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that any person or entity having a claim arising from the rejection of an unexpired lease or executory contract shall file proof of such claim on or prior to the date fixed in the order authorizing such rejection. If no such date is specified, proof of such claim shall be filed on or before the later of (i) the Bar Date and (ii) thirty (30) days after entry of the order authorizing such rejection.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that copies of the Schedules of Assets and Liabilities, Statements of Financial Affairs, Executory Contracts, and Lists of Equity Security Holders will be made available for inspection during regular business hours no later than December 18, 1991 at (i) the Office of Weil, Gotschal & Manges, Attorneys for the Debtors, NCND Plaza, 901 Main Street, Suite 4100, Dallas, Texas 75202, and (ii) the Office of the Clerk, United States Bankruptcy Court, Northern District of Indiana, 224 United States Courthouse, 204 South Main Street, South Bend, Indiana 46601. 
