The council will meet at 6 p.m. in executive session in the lower level conference room. Labor negotiations and pending litigation will be discussed.

The 7:30 p.m. meeting will begin with two public hearings.

- Introduction of a zoning text amendment to regulate the location of accessory buildings.
- Introduction of a zoning text amendment to specify areas available for future Industrial-Research-Office development.

The council will consider enactment of ordinance amending the traffic and motor vehicles sections of the city code.

Also to be considered is approval of a letter in opposition to Senate Bill 522, as well as a resolution urg-

ing reinstatement of Michigan Air Quality Control Commission. Members also will consider adoption of a resolution supporting passage of Senate Bill 576, the code of criminal procedure.


