Planking is a method of serving fish rather than of cooking it. Since the arrangement takes time, planked fish will probably be served only on special occasions fish with thick fiesh is best suited to planking. Arrange the fish with melted butter or French dressing. Bake in a moderate own for 20 to 30 min. meanwhile preparing two to three vegetables. Arrange a border of mashed potato a round the fish when done, making a nest for each vegetable. Add vegetables, gernish with parsley, and serve.

HELPFUL HINT: Planked fish may be placed under the broiler to brown, but do not let the fish or platter become exposed to flame.
