Reginald Roquemore, former cilin cowner, age 44, of Defroit (Grmerly of West Bloomfield) — 10 years in prison without parole, and a \$10,000 fine.
The defendants were convicted by

The defendants were convicted by a jury on Aug. 8, after a three-month trial in federal court, according to assistant U.S. attorneys Wayne F. Pratt and Janice V. Terbush, who prosecuted the case.

THE DEFENDANTS' SENTENC-ES arose from their involvement in the Second Selden Medical Clinic, a now-defunct enterprise that operat-ed in the Cass corridor area of De-


