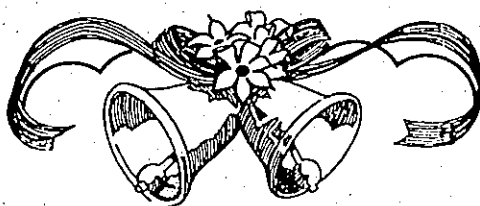
A July wedding is planned in St. Thomas in Ann Arbor.
