## Crash puts local teen in critical condition

A 17-year-old North Farmington High School student was listed in critical condition Tuesday at the University of Michigan Hospital, Ann Arbor, following a traffic accident about 3:10 p.m. Feb. 14 at Foxgrove and 13 Mile roads, according of Farmington Hills police.

Jennifer Hextall, the driver of a 1887 four-door Chrysler, made what is believed to be a rolling stop at the intersection of Foxgrove and 13 Mile, when she was struck broadshad, 24, of Farmington Hills, according Sgl. Ray Cranston of the Farmington Hills Police Department's traffic section. traffic section.

Hextall, and her sister, Brooke, 16, a passenger in the car and a North Farmington High School student, were both wearing seatbelts. Jennifer Hextall was transported Sun-

day from Botaford General Hospital, Farmington Hills, to the U-M hospital where she is in the pediatric intensive care unit, according to a hospital spokeswoman. Brooke Hextall, was treated at Botaford General Hospital, Farmington Hills, and released, as was Takial, Cranston said.
Hextall was apparently attempting to turn eastbound on 13 Miles, when Takial, who was driving westbound on the thoroughlare, struck her car. The accident is still under investigation. There is no reason believe excessive speed was a factor in the accident, Cranston added.
