"I AM THE average person walk-lag around in my district," he contin-ued. "I am surrounded by everyday life as a businessman, taxpayer, hus-band, father and homeowner. I un-derstand the problems of the day."

Chapman said he has three planks in his platform:

• More jobs/less taxes.

Eliminate government waste and the deficit.

Abandon pork, perks and paralysis.

Ile said he would work to balance the budget by cutting out the \$180 billion identified as waste by the Bush administration, trimming the defense budget by hiring out the de-fense of Europe and Asia, and other-wise effectively streamlining the consentment.

Chapman does not support national health insurance, but instead suggests "alternative pilot health programs" be tested out in different parts of the country. He supports a tax credit for persons with no health insurance.

"Government has busted the backs of business," he said. "The offshoot of this has been a reduction of jobs, I support unferter daccess to absolute free trade which I believe will lead business to create new products and new jobs."
