Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week:

MAN ARRESTED

An 18-year-old Redford Township man was arrested in the parking lot of a Farmington shopping center March 21 for possessing a dangerous weapon.

Confiscated at the scene was a 15-inch pipe.

Police on patrol in the area of Maude's Pizza, 23331 Orchard Lake Road, spotted a man as he walked in the lot carrying a pipe. The officer stopped the man who said he was looking for a Farmington High School student who he claimed had been making harassing phone calls to his house. He was carrying the pipe, he said, for protection.

Maude's Pizza is frequented by Farmington High students during their lunch hour, according to police, who state in their report that the department has been called to the location on "numerous occasions" for fighting, disorderly conduct and obstruction of business.

The 18-year-old was released pending warrants.

LEAKY GENERATOR

Farmington Hills firefighters removed light smoke from the Kmart building at 30800 Orchard Lake Saturday after a generator leaked oil onto an electrical panel and blew fuses. There was no fire and little damage reported in the incident which occurred shortly before 9 a.m.

Fire officials report they were put on hold by Detroit Edison for a half-hour when trying to call and report the power outage to the commercial building.

INDECENT EXPOSURE

A clerk at the Wishing Well Gifts, 355125 Grand River, reported that a man exposed himself in the store March 23. According to Farmington Department of Public Safety reports, the man entered the store shortly before 8 p.m., and walked behind a rack. When he walked from behind the rack, he was exposing himself. The man eventually left the store and drove away in a Dodge Shadow.

BREAK-IN REPORTED

The owner of a house on Freedom Road returned home March 21 to find the house ransacked and thousands of dollars in personal items stolen. A total of \$6,453 in cash, dresses and jewelry were taken from at least two bedrooms in the house. Police are investigating.

Police investigate city woman's death in hit-and-run accident

Farmington Hills police are investigating the death of a Livonia woman in a hit-and-run traffic accident Monday at 9:55 p.m. on Grand River at Rockwell near Eight Mile.

Pedestrian Darlene Reynolds, 29, was in the south-eastbound lane at Rockwell when she was hit, according to Hills chief William Dwyer.

She was apparently crossing Grand River from the north to the south.

"There was an autopsy this morning (Tuesday)," Dwyer said. "We're still attempting to find witnesses. We can't say anymore at this time." The woman was thrown 100 feet, Dwyer said.

The driver who struck Reynolds fled the scene without identifying himself, police said.

The vehicle should show damage to the front bumper area or undercarriage.


