

Cranbrook seeks docent aides

The Cranbrook Academy of Art Museum is accepting applications for its docent program.

Docents are volunteers who provide guided tours of the museum's collections and special exhibitions for school and adult groups.

An open house will take place for prospective applicants at 10 a.m. Monday, June 22, at the museum. Call David Rau, associate curator, at 645-1314 for more information and an application.

Docents must complete a semester-long training program that includes tour techniques and the history of the museum's collection and the Cranbrook Education Community.

Men and women interested in Cranbrook and contemporary art who are available for training on Mondays and touring on at least one other weekday during the school year are encouraged to consider this challenging and rewarding service to the community.

The docent program will begin in September 1992. Experience with public speaking or teaching is an important qualification for the docent program. But enthusiasm and a sincere willingness to learn supercede all other qualifications.

The Cranbrook Academy of Art Museum is open to the public for general viewing 1-5 p.m. Wednesday-Sunday, with extended hours from 9:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. the first Thursday of the month. For more information, call 645-3323.

Max painted two murals, with a total 10,000 square feet, for the U.S. pavilion at Expo '92 in Spain. Called "Discovery," the work is a top attraction.

Popular in Russia

Max, whose work is featured in 140 museums around the world, found special success in Russia. In 1989, he designed the largest rock and roll stage for the Moscow Music and Dance Festival. His work was shown in a 25-year retrospective at the Hermitage Museum last May.

At the opening of the retrospective, 14,000 people attended, making it the largest opening day turnout for an artist in Russian history.

"It was an implosion. The lines went around 10 blocks," said Max.

Participants will be able to sample some of Ann Arbor's finest pastries.

The auction will feature an eclectic mix of works donated by co-op members, as well as gift certificates and other items donated to the co-op.

Painting, drawing, photography, sculpture, ceramics, jewelry and fabric art are among the media represented. Some works will be sold through a silent auction and the rest will go in a live auction conducted by a professional auctioneer.

Viewing will take place 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. The auction will begin at 1 p.m. Free parking will be available.

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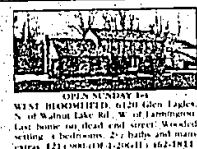
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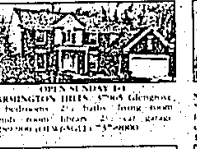
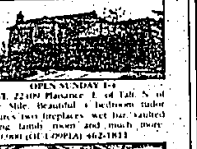
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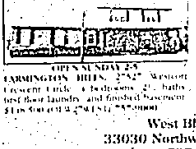
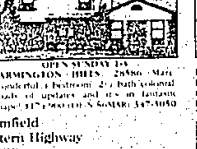
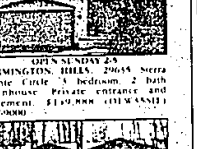
