

New precincts prompt voter card change

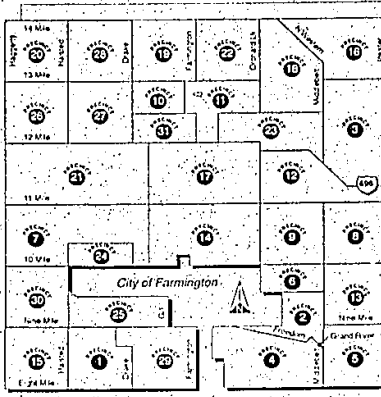
When you get a new Farmington Hills voters registration card in the mail within the week, don't throw it away. It's different than the one you already have.

"They (voters) need to toss out that old card and use the new card," City Clerk Kathy Duran said. "If you don't get one, call the city clerk's office."

That new card will reflect some changes in city voting precincts, as well as school voting precincts, which have been doubled. That card will tell you where you have to vote in the June 8 school election. It also reflects location changes and address changes for precincts where you must vote in city, state and federal elections, beginning with the Aug. 4 primary.

Changes have been made in some of the city's voting precincts where you will vote for city, state, county and federal offices and ballot proposals. Here are changes made to the precinct map:

- Precincts 24 and 27, which formerly voted at Hillside Elementary School, have been combined.
- Precinct 24 will be at Farmington Tyndale College, 35700 12 Mile.
- Precinct 27 will be at fire headquarters, 28711 Drake Road.
- Precinct 26 was split. If your card says precinct 26 you will vote at Hope Lutheran Church, 30200 12 Mile.
- Precinct 7 was readjusted and now voters will vote at Hillside Elementary School, 30801 11 Mile.
- Precinct 14, which was added to, will be at Alameda School, 32400 Alameda.
- Other changes include new locations for some precincts as follows:
 - Precinct 2, formerly at Wheeler fire hall, now will be at Farmington Community School, 30415 Shinawassee.
 - Precinct 5, formerly at William Grace, will now be at St. Alexander's Church, 27835 Shinawassee.
 - Precinct 7, formerly at Dunckel Middle School, will be at Hillside Elementary School, 30801 11 Mile.
 - Precinct 12, formerly at East Middle School, will be at Mercy Center, 28600 11 Mile.
 - Precinct 17, formerly at Alameda School, will be at First Presbyterian Church, 26165 Farmington Road.
 - Precinct 20, formerly at fire headquarters, will be at William Tyndale College, 35700 12 Mile.
 - Precinct 21, formerly at Dunckel Middle School, will be at Forest Park Baptist Church, 20805 Farmington Road.
 - Precinct 24, formerly at Hillside Elementary School, will be at William Tyndale College, 35700 12 Mile.
 - Precinct 27, formerly at Hillside Elementary School, will be at fire headquarters, 28711 Drake Road.
 - Precinct 29, formerly at Power Middle School, will be at the Finnish Center, 35200 Eight Mile Road.
 - Precinct 34, formerly at Woodside Elementary School, will be at Dunckel Middle School, 32800 12 Mile.
