

Work by B'ham artist on view

Kyoung Ae Cho of Birmingham is one of four artists whose work is featured in Art on the Move, an installation in the Grand Circus Park area in Detroit.

Art on the Move is an artist residency program sponsored by the Grand Circus Park Development Association and the Detroit Recreation Department. Its four unusual and exciting sculptural installations may be viewed Monday-Wednesday, June 22-24. The artists who created them will attend Monday evening and at noon Tuesday and Wednesday.

Cho's art work is "Journey," a 10-foot long shiplike structure that will be installed in the greenspace between the Fox and State theaters. It is made of gathered materials and shredded printed text bound together with wire. It represents the journey of life and hope for the possibilities of the future.

The residency program, in its seventh year, is designed to challenge Michigan artists to experiment with large scale, temporary art for public places.

An exhibit at the Arts Extended Gallery, on the second floor of the David Whitney Building, 1553 Woodward Ave. in Detroit, showcases additional studio art work by the four resident artists, as well as the proposal boards submitted by all 34 entrants to this year's contest.

This exhibit, curated by MaryAnn Wilkinson of the Detroit Institute of Arts, runs noon to 5 p.m. Wednesday-Saturday to June 27. The display will be open 5:30-9:30 p.m. June 22 during the Grand Circus Park Development Association's spotlight tour of the theater district.

Jurors for Art on the Move 1992 included Wilkinson; Ann Treadwell, director of the Creative Arts Center of Pontiac; Gene Backlin, former director of Detroit Focus Gallery; artist Charles McGhee; and George Vary, deputy chief of landscape design, Detroit Recreation Department.

Of the installation pieces, Berkley resident Robert Neilson "built" "Blaim," an oversized, target-shaped sculpture placed at Grand Circus Park East.

The other artists are Detroiters Sandra Bauld, whose work features four revolving arms, supported by a 12-foot central pole, that passersby may turn; and Kalamazoo artist Lou Rizzolo, whose sculpture features a long, helium-filled tube that will float skyward from the Edison fountain in Grand Circus Park West.

Exhibit to celebrate Michigan artists

All Michigan artists 18 and older are eligible for the sixth annual Celebrate Michigan Artists exhibition, Aug. 22 to Sept. 23, at the Paint Creek Center for the Arts.

Two- and three-dimensional works in all media, not exceeding 60 inches in any direction, are eligible. Art work must have been completed within the past two years and not previously exhibited at the PCCA.

Preliminary selection for Celebrate Michigan Artists will be done by 35mm slides. The deadline for slide entries is Friday, July 3.

Artists interested in entering this year's competition should write for an entry form to Paint Creek Center for the Arts, 407 Pine, Rochester, Mich. 48307, or call the PCCA at 651-4110, 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Tuesday-Saturday.

First place award is \$1,000, underwritten by an Arts Foundation of Michigan grant. Second prize is \$500, third prize is \$250. Four runners-up will receive honorable mention prizes of \$50 each.

The first place entry will be reproduced as a fine art poster.

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Gardening guru sets session

America's gardening guru, Jerry Baker, will be on hand 1:30-3:30 p.m. Saturday, June 20, at B Dalton Bookseller in Wonderland Mall, Livonia, to autograph copies of his new book, "Plants Are Still Like People."

The Troy-based author has written more than three-dozen highly popular books on gardening, including "The Impatient Gardener" and "Make Friends With Your Annuals."

In each, he offers his own brand of down-to-earth advice to gardeners everywhere.

The former undercover officer, who, in his law enforcement days, often posed as a gardener, advises fertilizing with lawn food, beer, flea shampoo, and household ammonia, for instance.

Compost can be easily made in a kitchen blender, he says, using table scraps, coffee grounds and other assorted ingredients gardeners can find around the house.

Baker's latest book is a revised, updated version of "Plants Are Like People," the million-seller he wrote 20 years ago and which he describes as "a blend of my gardening philosophy and my sound of fashioned advice."

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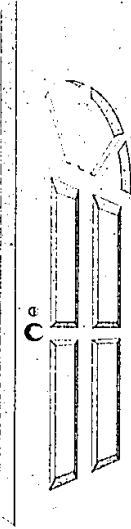
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
