

cause the nails I used were poorly galvanized and started to cust. I tried to remove the stains with vine-gar, mineral spirits, household bleach, steel wool and TSP, but nothing helped. Do you have a solu-tion?

Oxalic acid will remove your rust stains. Dissolve one tablespoon of crystals in one cup of warm water. Wear rubber gloves and gagles. If you can't find malic acid, use DuPont's Heavy Duy Cooling System Cleaniser for cars. It has oxalic acid in it. This treatment, box-ver, will only remove rust strains, and not prevent further rusting. Try painting the nail heads with anti-rust ipaint. The problem could have been prevented by using altuminium mails. However, if you have to hang siding over a hard substrate, such as asbestos shingles, then use hat dipped galvanized nails.
