Classes for youngsters include a variety of choices in clay, drawing, painting, papermaking, sculpture and storytelling. Young adults, age 10 and older, have their choice of classes in clay, drawing, portraiture and sculpture.

Adults, as well as interested high school students, can pick from a list of 21 classes and nine workshops conveniently scheduled mornings, afternoons and evenings. Class offerings include art appreciation, clay, drawing, painting, papermaking, photography, printmaking and sculpture.

Classes open in music, dance, visual arts

Registration for the non-degree programs at the Center for Creative Studies is now open.

Many different programs in dance, music and visual arts are available to beginners through professionals.

Summer dance studies for youths and adults include ballet, modern, Dunham, tap, East Indian and First Studio, a beginning dance class designed for preschoolers.

Private and group music lessons in classical and jazz are available in all instruments and voice. A folk group performance class is offered for ages 16 and above. A multi-discipline workshop for ages 4-13 includes music, movement and visual arts experiences. Jazz ensemble, beginning group piano, class voice and

theory studies are also available.

Summer visual arts studies include a five-week pre-college program for students considering applying to a professional visual arts

college; courses for students in grades 3-12 include drawing and painting, photography, ceramics, and sculpture; and courses for adults and advanced high school




