and possibly some creative reviews of the current building space if the state approves adding a third judge. "Why expand if you don't have to?" he said. "It's utilization of the building - there's so many creative things you can do. I wouldn't be leading the bandwagen to build a new courtroom." Meanwhile, McDonald believes a judge should oim for shorter case resolution by making better use of time and technology to operate the courts.

McDonald is an advocate of creative sentencing including, for example, forcing a young person who has damaged a lawn to repair that one and 20 others. "I represent a lot of kids," he said, "Most are pretty good, and they might do something stupid. But I don't think they should go into court and pay a fine and walk away."

He said he could change the public perception of "judge as God." "Sometimes judges as that way, and they deserve the criticism," he said. "Practicing law's hard. It's very difficult and that's why you don't need a judge making it any harder."
