Under unfinished business, the council will consider enacting an ordinance to rezone the northeast corner of Drake and 12 Mile from one-family residential to special purpose district. The proponent is Damone/Andrew Inc. and the owner Khafer and Fatima Elzei. Also under old business is consideration of enacting an ordinance regarding temporary uses in the city, amending principal uses in an office research district and amending the city's nuisance ordinance regarding outside storage of firewood.

Under new business, the council will review the city's Solicitor's Ordinance, consider an amendment to city council rules and procedures regarding election endorsements, consider appointments to the Michigan League Annual Convention, and consider approval of a consent judgment in Micropolis

Village vs. Farmington Hills.
The city manager will report on Wixom land acquisition and denial control program, update the council on status of pesticide and herbicide applicator regulations and report on a tentative agreement with the Michigan Department of Natural Resources for land trust grant to acquire park property.

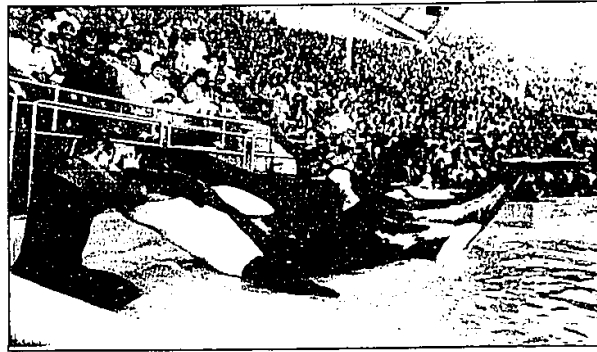
