

Colorful Aphids Drain Sap, Kill Hybrid Plants

A well-grown large clump of delphinium is a real traffic-stopper. There is nothing to equal the stately beauty of a mass of Pacific Giant hybrids in full bloom. It is also true that there is nothing more sorry than a clump that has been attacked by aphids. If the leaves of yours have a cupped appearance, turn over a few of them and take a look. The quickest glance will tell you if the pests are present. They are large and conspicuous, shiny, round, and colorful.

YOU CAN FIND aphids in a great array of colors—green, gray-green, pink, yellow, or orange. No matter what the color, they all feed by thrusting pointed hollow portions of their beaks into the plant and sucking the sap.

They reproduce madly and there are soon so many on a stalk that there is literally no standing room left. Some have had luck in getting rid of them by using a pressurized spray can containing a mixture of pyrethrum and rotenone.

NO SPRAY of any kind should be used without reading the entire label. For instance, certain sprays must never be used on viburnums, and you can learn this from the printing on the package.

WHEN black raspberry plants reach a height of two feet, the tips of the shoots should be pinched out so that the plants will not grow taller. Purple raspberries should be allowed to get somewhat tall—perhaps another six inches.

Cluttered Tools Are Dangerous

One trouble with garden tools is that one tends to be tripping over them all the time. It does little good for one's limb or for the tools. Hanging them up out of the way will prevent accidents, save room and save wear and tear on the tools. Hanging them up in a makeshift manner, however, may be worse than leaving them about—especially if there are children around.

Children, and adults too, can be injured by pulling down tools that are hung on nails or hooks. When you hang your tools along a garage wall, provide a means of keeping them from falling. A strip of wood nailed across garage studs can serve as a retainer.

TOOLS on hooks can be kept in place with bits of light chain hooked over the handle and placed high enough to be out of the reach of children.

Use a fence staple at one end and a screen door hook at the other to hold the chain in place. Nails or hooks can be used to hold the tool itself—a pair of nails for a rake, for example.

Small tools—clippers, trowels and the like—can be held securely in another manner. Make a shelf out of scrap wood and nail it between joists of a garage wall. Instead of placing the tools on the shelf, cut holes big enough for the tool to fit in but not big enough to fall through.

Sharp tools, such as a scythe, should be hung high and out of the way and be retained with a chain. Pails, sprinkling cans and similar containers can be hung overhead. Do not use nails. The items can be too easily knocked off. Use hooks instead.

FUEL for your power mower should be kept in a tightly capped metal can. Keep it up on a shelf out of the way. Insecticides should also be kept in tightly stoppered and break-proof containers. Keep in a locked cabinet.
