Hixson At Large

The concept of juvenile delinquency is itself juvenile. It was only a few years ago that our society deplored the apathy of youth. Now more recently it is the activism of students that is deplored. Schizophrenia may be the sole inheritance of our future generations.

In the 1950's, Kenneth Kenniston wrote "The Uncommitted," which condemned the lack of social concern in young people.

This book indicated alarm at "The Organization Man" mentality, prevalent among young people at that time. Now it is the activist who is the object of study in the works of Sanford and Katz. It is the activist who alarms the public.

SURPRISINGLY, however, the activist tends to be the more intelligent student as these studies indicate. He emerges from the humanities and the social sciences. He scores better on almost all psychological measurement tests.

The adult world has apparently been guilty of two dimensional thinking, condemning all youth by implication. Youth like everyone else tend to live up to the expectations of others.

Lamentations about youth were heard even in ancient Egypt and Athens. Youth has always been a convenient scapegoat.

The parent frequently works his problems out on his children. The teacher often works his problems out in the classroom. Society works its problems out on its youth.

Youth, it turns out, is the conscience of our country. They have forced a national examination of purpose, however temporary and futile it may have been.

If the violence of a minority is unfortunate, the insensibility of adults is equally regrettable. It is forgotten that the emotionally disturbed are the products of the parental environment.

IN ITS DESPERATE search for the new and the startling, television has focused on a hippie minority. By so doing the adult world of television has generated more hippies than any single force. That which we condemn is apparently that which fascinates us.

The schools have constantly told students to think for themselves. Now for the first time students have accepted the challenge. They are thinking for themselves. And actually there is good reason for a reactionary public to be alarmed.

Somehow (and no one really knows how) the schools have unleashed a tide of thinkers.

Of such thinking individuals Emerson has said, "Beware when the Great God lets loose a thinker on this planet. Then all things are at risk."

"It is as when a great conflagration has broken out in a great city, and no man knows what is safe or where it will end. There is not a piece of science, but its flank may be turned tomorrow; there is not any literary reputation, not the so-called eternal names of fame, that may not be revised and condemned."

"The very hope of man, the thought of his heart, the religions of nature, the manners and morals of mankind, are all at the mercy of a new generalization."

Somehow these words sum up our wonderful youth. If an individual is only as vital as his ideas, our thinking youth are very vital indeed.
