## Substance-free dorms

Here is a sampling of housing programs at state-funded universities for students seeking drug and alcohol-free dorms. Also shown are the percentage of students utilizing substance-free housing at each university.

University	Policy	Percentage of students
Central Michigan	Substance-free housing is not an option except for recovering drug addicts.	Not available.
Eastern Michigan	Three substance-free floors, plus a substance-free roommate option.	20%
Ferris State	Substance-free housing is not an option, except for recovering drug addicts.	Not available.
Grand Valley State	Alcohol prohibited in all rooms.	100%
Lake Superior	Three alcohol-free dorms, which house all first-year students and students over 21 who request alcohol-free rooms.	Not available
Michigan State	Substance-free roommate option.	2%
Michigan Technical	Alcohol-free roommate option.	Not available
Northern Michigan	Alcohol is only allowed in 20% of rooms, available by request. In addition, 2% of students may choose "chemical-free" housing, in which they abstain from alcohol, tobacco and drugs at all times.	80%
Oakland	One substance-free dorm, plus a substance-free roommate option.	10%
U-M Ann Arbor	Substance-free floors and rooms.	20%
U-M Dearborn	No student housing.	Not applicable
U-M Flint	No student housing.	Not applicable
Saginaw Valley State	Alcohol-free housing is available for students over 21. Alcohol is prohibited in other student's dorms.	95%
Wayne State	Substance-free roommate option.	Not available
Western Michigan	Alcohol-free housing available.	Not available

hol," said Colleen Tompkins, who handles housing for Eastern Michigan University.

There is also a more pragmatic explanation. "Oftentimes," Tompkins acknowledged, "parents are the ones filling out the requests. If students are up there (in substance-free housing) drinking, it means their parents filled out the forms."

### Not for parents

Indeed, Western Michigan University has started asking parents not to fill out the forms.

"They want the best for their son or daughter," said Cheryl Nickel,

who directs housing for WMU. "But we used to get parents who thought their son or daughter didn't smoke, so they'd check that on the form. Then, we'd end up with a smoker rooming with a non-smoker."

Alcohol-free housing isn't an issue at Grand Valley State University in Grand Rapids for one simple reason: all dorms are, by the University's rules, alcohol-free. The policy, which has been in effect since the mid-80s, has met with overall acceptance, according to hall director Jackie Rhodes.

"Parents love it," she said. "Students are students, and they'll try to get around it, but they understand it."
