## WILLIAM K. LOMASON

Mr. Lomason, 82, chairman of the board of Douglas & Lomason Co. headquartered in Farmington Hills, died Sept. 2 in Atlanta, Ga.

Born in Detroit, Mr. Lomason attended Detroit Public Schools. He graduated from the University of Michigan in 1932 with a bachelor of arts degree and in 1933 with a master of arts degree. In 1934, he began his 58-year career with the company that was co-founded by his father.

Upon his father's death, he became president and general manager until 1976, when he was elected chairman of the board and chief executive officer.

Mr. Lomason's long association with the Episcopal Church began when he was a chorist and acolyte at St. Paul's Cathedral in Detroit. Since his childhood, he had served on church vestries and committees for All Saints in Detroit and Christ Church Cranbrook in Bloomfield Hills and St. Phillips Cathedral and St. Dunstan's in Atlanta, Ga.

A lover of music and grand opera, he dedicated himself to the Metropolitan Opera National Council's annual auditions for young and aspiring singers. He was the Council's Southern Regional Auditions

Chairman, as well as having been its Regional Auditions Director from 1983 to 1987. He also supported the Atlanta Opera, serving as a director; the Atlanta Symphony; the Detroit Symphony and the Michigan Opera Theatre.

He was chairman of the Youth Service Committee in the 1950s for the Rotary Club of Detroit and honored as a Paul Harris Fellow for his contributions to social causes.

On the national level, he has been vice-chairman of the National Right to Work committee, director and member of the Executive Committee and director of the National Right to Work Legal Defense Foundation.

Mr. Lomason's membership in professional organizations included the Engineering Society of Detroit, the American Electrotechnical Society, the Detroit Economic Club and the Newcomen Society of the United States.

As a result of his commitment to professional and civic affairs, he was awarded a citation for community service by the Marianna Lee County Lions Club of Arkansas and the Man of the Year Award from Carrollton, Ga., Chamber of Commerce. He was named Lt. Colonel Aide de Camp of the Governor's Staff of Georgia; Admiral of the Great Navy of the State of Nebraska; Arkansas Traveler; and Honorary Mayor of the City of Milan, Tenn.

Mr. Lomason was a member of the Capital City Club and Commerce Club in Atlanta, Ga., the Detroit Club, Detroit Athletic Club, Detroit Golf Club, Renaissance Club of Detroit, Sunset Hills Country Club and Marianna Country Club.

Survivors include his wife, Ruth McWilliams Martin; son, Harry A. Lomason; daughters, Jane Agostinelli and Anne Bray; stepsons, Thomas and Kenneth Martin; stepdaughter, Kathleen Forlines; 15 grandchildren and four great-grandchildren.

Services were held Sept. 4 in Spring Hill Funeral Home, Atlanta, Ga. Church services were Sept. 5 in All Saints Episcopal Church in Atlanta, Ga.

## BETTY JOY RUTHERFORD


Mrs. Rutherford, 74, of Farmington died Sept. 4.
