

Symphony League Eats Well

The Plymouth Symphony League luncheon was revived this year and the 75 or so members who attended agreed it was worth reviving. The league is divided into groups with the fund-raising projects rotating each year. Each group is involved in the symphony ball, the round robin bridge, 'pop' concert, antique mart or one of the other activities. The luncheon is the only opportunity for everyone to get together, get to know each other, and assess the season's labors.

Another reason for its success was the fine food prepared by the ladies of St. John Episcopal Church on Sheldon Road. Jerry Stewart, Phyllis Ordling and their nine helpers selected a perfect luncheon menu. The Party Ham Salad was served on a bed of lettuce with plenty of little hot rolls and butter. They made 16 times the recipe below—enough to serve about 90 people.

PARTY HAM SALAD
1 envelope (1 T) unflavored gelatin
1/2 c. cold water
1/2 c. boiling water
1 c. dairy sour cream
1/2 c. mayonnaise or salad dressing
3 T. vinegar
1/2 t. salt
Dash pepper
1 1/2 c. diced cooked or canned ham
1 c. diced celery
1/2 c. chopped green pepper
3 T. chopped green onions

Soften gelatin in cold water; dissolve in boiling water. Blend in sour cream, mayonnaise, vinegar, salt and pepper. Chill until partially set; whip until fluffy. Fold in remaining ingredients. Pour into 5 1/2-cup ring mold. Chill until firm. Makes five to six servings. (They made theirs in slab cake pans and cut it in squares to serve.)

CHOCOLATE DESSERT
1 angel food cake
1 can prepared chocolate pudding
1 small pkg. chocolate chips
2 pkg. dessert topping
Break cake into bite-sized pieces and mix with the pudding. Add chocolate chips. Spread in nine by 13-inch cake pan and top with the whipped dessert topping. Refrigerate overnight. Phyllis Ordling said they made six of these the day before the luncheon. The servings were generous.

FOR THOSE who worked on the first symphony luncheon 10 years ago, three things should stand out, the daisies, Thelma Couts rolls and her cashew-chicken salad.

The daisies were the centerpiece, and these were no ordinary daisies. The whole group made a trip to a craft store in Dearborn to learn how to make them. There followed weekly meetings where each flower was carefully assembled and finally, arranged in bowls. This was back in the very low budget days, before the round robin bridge and the antique mart. The hope was that the guests would want to buy the centerpiece and thus help offset the cost of the luncheon.

Thelma Couts, with the help of some ladies of the First Methodist Church, prepared and served that first luncheon. Thelma's rolls have a reputation of long standing. Here is the recipe as it appears in the Methodist Church cookbook:

REFRIGERATOR ROLLS
2 eggs
1/2 c. sugar
2/3 c. margarine
1 yeast cake
2 c. warm water
6 c. flour, before sifting
1 t. salt

Dissolve yeast in 1/3 cup warm water and one half teaspoon sugar and let stand five minutes. Beat eggs, sugar and margarine. Then add yeast. Stir in remaining water, flour and salt, sifted together. Cover bowl tightly and store in refrigerator until ready to use. Shape into rolls and let raise until double in bulk. Bake at 400 degrees for 20 minutes.
