Farmington reports \$100,000 water leak

Farmington officials believe they have found a "substantial" water system leak which cost the city about \$100,000 last year—something noted in a recent annual financial report given to the city council by Plante & Moran accounting firm.

City Manager Robert Deadman said public services employees found a "substantial break" in the system along Orchard Lake Road which has since been repaired. Nonetheless, they will be monitoring city water lines on a quarterly basis to be sure they have caught the problem.
