Because Mr. and Mrs. Donald Strand of Livonia bought a mobile home and started making regular visits to Florida three years ago, women in this area are going to get a chance to learn about shellcraft.

Eleanora Strand, always interested in a wide variety of craft skills, has in the last few years learned how to fashion tiny shells into bouquets of flowers, pictures, whimsical animals and decorative boxes.

She'll teach others how to use shells creatively when she starts an adult education class next fall in Redford Union High School.

Continued from Page 1C encouragement in the birth method she chose, and Seaway Hospital in Trenton was picked for the birth of both babies because it permits husbands to be present in the delivery room.

"You could do it this way without encouragement from either husband or doctor," she said, "but it would be most difficult."

The Childbirth Preparation Association soon will be starting new series of classes in Dearborn, Trenton, Taylor and Wyandotte locations, and hopes within a few months to start classes in Redford. Women interested in the series are invited to write to the association, P.O. Box 73, Lincoln Park.

Another Lamaze group holds series of classes in Plymouth and may be reached through Mrs. Alan Woodworth, 171 Blunk, Plymouth. Women are urged to register early in pregnancy and they take the classes during the final eight weeks.

LOTS OF PRACTICE in breathing and limbering exercises is the big thing in preparation, Carol Caletson said. She pointed out that the French physician Lamaze's predecessor in the birth method was the famed Russian Pavlovsky.

"The idea is that you learn to associate the contractions with the proper kind of breathing," she added.

She also emphasized that women must have their doctor's permission to take the classes and that many do take medication when they or their physician decide it's advisable.

"This is not an endurance test, and we have no failures," she said.

"I just wish every woman could go through the series so she doesn't go into the birth experience frightened. So often giving birth has been pictured as an agonizing experience and it doesn't have to be that way."

"Birth can be so beautiful."

Women To Vote Against War By Not Buying

All American women who want the war to end are being asked to vote no to the war by not spending any money on goods and services on June 21.

The project is planned by a group called Women United to End the War.

The action has its foundation in a Gallup poll statistic showing that 78 per cent of American women want the U.S. out of Vietnam by December 1971.

JUNE 21 HAS been chosen since it is the longest day of the year. Unless the war stops, the women plan to protest again Sept. 21 and Dec. 21. In Plymouth it is being supported by the Northville Plymouth branch of the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom, who will reach local community women's groups with the plan. Those wishing to participate may call Barbara Marshall, 1989 German Rd., Plymouth, or Alice Woodruff, 20145 Beck Rd., Northville.

The action has been spread by word of mouth and by correspondence, from women writing to their Christmas card lists to contacts with church groups and other women's organizations.

THE IDEA ORIGINATED among middle-class American women, who have taken as a slogan Arnold Toynbee's words, "The mothers of America have still

to go into action. I believe this is a battle the Pentagon cannot win."

An unexpected offshoot of the action occurred when a husband who donated to the operating fund was dubbed an "honorary woman." Since then, all men who are supporting the cause have received this title.

The action is planned to include all spending. One woman has changed her moving day and others will leave notes for their paperboys and milkmen.

Women who have endorsed the action include N.Y. Representative, Bella Abzug, Jane Hart, columnist Sidney Callahan, Dorothy Day, Jane Fonda, Mia Adaji of the women's division, Board of Missions, United Methodist Church, Barbara Avedon, author of "Another Mother for Peace," and Barbara Fuller, president of the Disciples Peace Fellowship.
