**Gymnastics Offered Here This Summer**

**FARMINGTON**  
A non-credit gymnastics program will be offered as part of the regular summer school lineup this year says Donald Howell, director of extended services for Farmington School District.

Open to all residents of the Farmington area, all classes will meet daily at Harrison High School from June 29-Aug. 10. Since these courses carry no credit, attendance is not mandatory.

Classes being offered are: "Beginning Tumbling and Trampoline," open to boys and girls who cannot execute a back handspring in tumbling or a back sommie on the trampoline. Careful progressions and spotting techniques will help students learn these and other tumbling and trampoline combinations. Time 8-9 a.m. or 9-10 a.m. Fee, \$15.

"Intermediate Tumbling and Trampoline." Students will build on basic skills to learn front and back sommies and layouts in tumbling and basic somersaulting combinations on the trampoline. Time - 9-10 a.m. or 11 a.m. Fee, \$15.

"Advanced Tumbling and Trampoline for Girls," basically open to girls who can perform consecutive back handsprings in tumbling and consecutive somersaulting moves on trampoline. Girls apparatus will also be studied. Time, 11 a.m. - noon. Fee, \$15.

"Beginning Boys Apparatus," an introduction of basic principles and techniques on boys parallel bars, high bar, side horse, vaulting and still rings. This course will be oriented to fourth, fifth and sixth grade boys. Time, 10-11 a.m. Fee, \$15.
