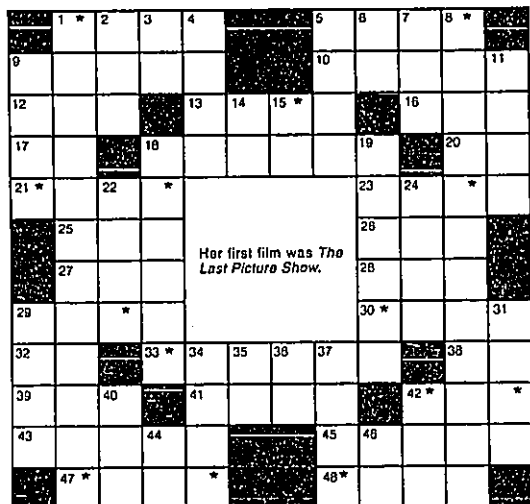


CROSSWORD PUZZLE

The answer to the Crossword Quiz is found within the answers in the puzzle. To find the answer, unscramble the letters noted with asterisks within the puzzle.

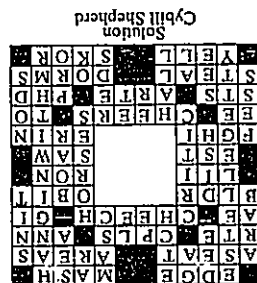

Dear Reader: Janis Paige portrays the matriarch of the Lockridge clan. She is a talented actress and has successfully worked in a variety of entertainment media. You may remember Paige from films such as *Hollywood Canteen*, *Silk Stockings* and *Please Don't Eat the Daisies*.

On Broadway, she created the role of Babe Williams in *The Pajama Game* and also starred in several other shows, including *Remains to Be Seen*.

Paige made her TV debut on *The Bob Hope Show* in 1950. Then came the starring role in the sitcom *It's Always Jan*, followed by roles on *Janigan's Rabbi*, *Gun Shy*, *Baby Makes Five*, *Eight Is Enough* and *Trapper John, M.D.* She appeared as a waitress on *All in the Family*, and last season she did two episodes with Linda Lavin on *Room for Two*.

Paige was no newcomer to daytime TV when she joined the cast of *SB*. She had portrayed Laureen Clegg on the soap *Capitol* and did a brief stint as a heart-transplant patient on *General Hospital*.
