# Not all cottage cheese is the same

and sliceable, similar to mozzarelia. This form is not a good substituto for cottage cheese.)

Creamed cottage cheese: Often made with whole milk, creamed cottage cheese contains about 4 percent (or more) fat. The free liq-uid often gives dishes a softer tex-

Low-fat cottage cheese: De-pending on the fat content of its milk base, this cheese can be el-ther 1 or 2 percent fat.

Dry curd cottage cheese: No milk is added to this cheese, giving it a drier, almost ricottalike texture. Like the nonfat version, it, too, is fat free.

Cottage cheese products: Cot-tage cheese can also be whipped, flavored, or mixed with tasty ingredients such as herbs, chopped vegetables, or spiced fruit. These products are meant for eating as is, rother than for use in cooking.

#### Cooking with cheese

Just as cottage cheese varies in fat content, it also comes in dif-ferent curd sizes, from small to large. Some manufacturers use such terms as California, pop-corn, country, farm and pot to de-scribe the curd size.

If you don't know what the terms mean on the labels in your supermarket, check with someone at the dairy counter who's familiar with the dairies in your area. Large curds work best for salads where they'll show up better.

Small curds can be used for smoother texture in cassercles, cheesecakes and other baked foods. In most recipes, you can use the plain cottage cheeses in-terchangeably. However, you should expect the creamed coltage cheeses to make recipes moister.

#### Quick ideas

Vegetable Dip: Combine cottage cheese with grated carrot, radish, or onion, then sprinkle with caraway seed and black peppers. Serve with broccoli flowerels or crackers.

Spiced Fruit Topping: In a covered blender container while cottage cheese with a dash of cinnomon and sugar. Serve on sliced apples.

Teatime Triangles: Spread triangles of cinnamon-raisin bread with a mixture of cottage cheese and chopped nuts.

Stuffed Celery: Stuff celery ribs with a mixture of drained cottage cheese, chopped green chilipeppers and ground cumin.

Muffin Melta: Spread pineapple-flavored cottage cheese onto

toasted English muffin halves.
Broil until golden.
Sandwich Spread: In a covered
blender container whirl cottage
cheese with a clove of garlie, as
spoonful of Parmesan cheese and
a few dashes of oregano and blace
popper. Spread between silces of
rye bread.
Stuffed Tomatoes: Stuff hollowed tomatoes with a mixture of
cottage cheese, finely chopped ofives and celery.
Cheesy Pasta Sauce: Combine
equal amounts of cottage chees
and plain yogurt. Sprinkle with
Parmesan cheese, ground nutmeg
and black pepper. Pour over hot,
cooked fettuccine and toss.

#### Storing cottage cheese

Storing cottage cheese
You can keep unopened cottage
cheese in the refrigerator for up to
a month after the "sell by" date
that's printed on its container.
Once the container is opened, or
to 10 days.
Store it in the original container
in the refrigerator. If there is
any mold on the cheese surface,
discard the entire container.
