The woman, age 24, told police that the man, age 28, punched the driver's side door window and broke it.

He reached in and began punching the woman and began shaking her. He kept saying: "I'll kill ya, . . . ," the report said.

Two female witnesses and employees observed the man choking the woman and another employee pulled the man off the woman, the report said.
