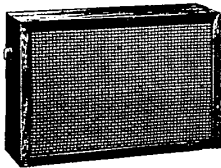

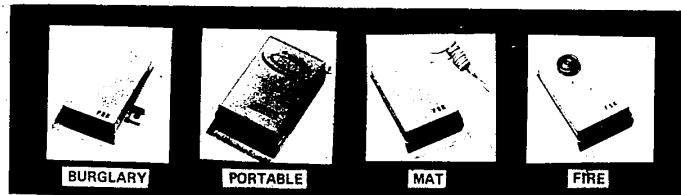

**HOW YOU CAN PREVENT BREAKINS
BURGLARPROOF YOUR HOME**

Don't go on vacation this summer or out to dinner tonight without taking some elementary precautions against burglars.
More and more in Farmington persons returning from a vacation or a night out are finding their homes ransacked, such valuables missing.
"We have an increasingly high number of breakings and entries in homes in the area," Farmington Judge Michael Hand said. "Some homes are hit three and four times."
Farmington Township has a 37 per cent increase and Farmington City a 30 per cent increase in breakings in 1970.
"If you are going out for the evening, don't leave the usual light in the living room on," Farmington City Public Safety Director Robert Deadman said. "A common burglar technique to determine if anyone is home is to knock at the front door."
"If someone answers, the burglar will ask for a fictitious person or directions, and if no one answers he will assume no one is home. However, when a light is on in the back or basement, the burglar might think the occupants can't hear his knock or are indisposed and thus might not answer the door."

"Leave a radio on," Deadman said. "It's unwise for a burglar to break in and hear noise."
"Leave the outside lights on. The better lighted the outside is, the less inviting to a burglar."
"Good locks on doors and windows are a must. Square bolts are good because they can't be wedged or pruned open," Deadman said.
"A sliding glass door is usually easily jammed, so put a length of pipe or wood in the track so it can't be opened."
LOTS OF PEOPLE are going to an alarm system, Farmington Township Police Chief Irving Yates said. "If there is a burglary or fire, an alarm is set off."
Most burglaries are in the evening from six to 11, both Yates and Deadman said, when the burglar has a better chance of finding an empty house.
"Burglary burglaries are very often apartment burglaries," Deadman said. "Again the best deterrents are good locks both on the lobby and individual apartment doors, and warning supervised activities."
Farmington is no longer a sleepy little community," Judge Hand said. "It is an affluent area that provides encouragement for burglars."

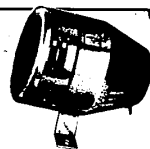
