THE FLORIDA Dept. of Agriculture sends along some helpful tips for the bride: Sprinkle lime juice over fresh sliced peaches to keep them bright and pretty.

Eggs peel more neatly if they don't crack during cooking. To help avoid this, pierce the top of the larger end with a pin, being sure to penetrate just the shell.

When hard-cooked eggs are done, cool at once in cold water-this helps prevent dark surface on yolk and makes for easier peeling.

Use a variety of salad greens in addition to head and leaf lettuce. Try Bibb or Boston lettuce, curly endive, romaine, and escarole.
