Dressed in shades of peasant browns and each with long beautiful hair, they are outspoken teenagers able to take on the political unrest in pre-Revolutionary Russia and sing about it vividly in "Matchmaker, Matchmaker." No cardboard voices in this show, Dallas has musical talent to work with — a lovely baritone in John Precee, a resonant tone with Gisele Carpenter in her solo "Sunrise, Sunset," and a cast deep with a solid sound.

In the pit, eight musicians follow up with the real fiddler, an electronic keyboard, a computer, and a phone carrying conductor for the 1993 version of the orchestra. They provide a strong Eastern-European rhythmic beat of the music.


